

2017-18 Health and Safety Policy Statement

In order to achieve the above commitments, the Board has set the following 2017-2018 objectives:

- Two Directors to attend the IOSH 'Leading Safely' course in May 2017 in order to improve competence (H&S1₁);
- Board to ensure it is leading by example, particularly with regard to carrying out regular audits and spot-checks of office premises and employee Health and Safety practice. Any corrective actions will be logged and acted upon to continually improve such areas (H&S1);
- All practitioners to improve competence and understanding of risk assessments through formal training and assessment (H&S5);
- Research and introduce company-wide, a robust paperless method of completing Point of Work Risk Assessments based on the risk assessment training (H&S5); and
- Successful implementation of the "Time to Change" Employers Pledge.

The implementation and documentation of this management system is achieved through the consistency of our quality management system, adopting the 'Plan, Do, Check, Act' methodology. This policy will be communicated to all our staff and interested parties and will be made available on our website www.lgluk.com.
